TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Please read these Terms and Conditions carefully as they apply to your participation at Dietitians Australia Conference 2022.

By attending, speaking, exhibiting, or sponsoring at Dietitians Australia Conference 2022, you agree to be bound by the Terms and Conditions set out below, which form a legally binding agreement between you and the Conference host – Dietitians Association of Australia, trading as Dietitians Australia. As a condition of attendance, in-person delegates must agree to adhere to all Covid-safe measures put in place by Dietitians Australia, the venue, federal or state guidelines and acknowledge that these procedures may be changed at any time in accordance with the latest health advice from the Australian Government.

Dietitians Australia and Think Business Events (Conference Organiser) reserve the right to publish changes to these Terms and Conditions at any time without prior notice.

PAYMENT OF REGISTRATION

The payment of the registration is either by credit card or bank deposit at the time of registration.

After 18 July 2022 midnight AEST, only payment made by credit card will be accepted.

A registration is considered complete when full payment is received by the Conference Organiser.

The Australian goods and services tax (GST) at 10% is applicable to all goods and services offered by the Conference. All registration fees listed include GST.

DISCOUNTED REGISTRATION FEES

Early Bird registration fees

To qualify for early bird registration, registration fees must be paid in full by 17 June 2022.

If registration fees have not been received by 17 June 2022 your registration will revert to the standard Conference registration fee.

Registration fees are based on date of payment receipt, not the date of receipt of registration form.

Member Registration

To qualify for member rates, you must be a member of Dietitians Australia. Your membership status will be verified upon registration. Your member number can be found in your [member portal](#).

Student Registration

The Student Rate applies to those who are student members of Dietitians Australia at the time of registration. Dietitians Australia membership is free for students currently enrolled in an [accredited dietetic education program](#). Your membership status will be verified upon registration. Your member number can be found in your [member portal](#).

LATE REGISTRATION

The Conference Organiser cannot guarantee the availability of collateral, such as satchels or social function tickets such as the Welcome Reception and/or the Conference Dinner to Delegates who register late (inside four weeks before the Conference starts) as there is a risk that social program functions may be fully subscribed. These tickets will be forfeited and the Conference registration fees will not be discounted.

TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION

All fully paid registrations are transferable to other persons from the same organisation.

Transfers can be made by the registered person in writing to the Conference Organiser at da@thinkbusinessevents.com.au no later than 18 July 2022. Details must include the full name of the replacement person, their title, contact phone number and email address. All other registration details will be carried over to the new person unless otherwise specified.

Transfer of registrations to another person will include the registration, all associated social event tickets (including additional purchases).

Should the new Delegate not require an item previously booked by the original Delegate, the cancellation and refund policy for the item cancelled will apply.

Registrations are individual and cannot be shared.

NON-ATTENDANCE/NO-SHOWS

No refund will be made for non-attendance at the Conference or social events.

CHANGE OF THE IN-PERSON REGISTRATION TO A VIRTUAL-ONLY REGISTRATION

At the Delegate's request due to government restrictions

If a Delegate is unable to travel to Adelaide to attend the Conference in-person due to government restrictions on travel as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic, the Delegate's registration will be converted to a virtual-only registration upon written request to the Conference Organiser.

In this scenario, the difference in the fees for an in-person registration and a virtual-only registration will be refunded. Refunds will be processed after the Conference. The Delegate accepts that the processing time for the refund may be delayed if many registrations need to be processed.

At the Delegate's request for other reasons

A Delegate may make a request in writing to the Conference Organiser to convert their in-person registration to a virtual registration for personal reasons not related to government restrictions on travel as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

If the request is made after 18 July 2022, the Delegate is not entitled to any refund or reduction of the registration fee applicable to the in-person registration.

Refunds will be processed after the Conference. The Delegate accepts that the processing time for the refund may be delayed if many registrations need to be processed.

Change of the virtual registration to an in-person registration

If a Delegate wants to convert their virtual registration to an in-person registration they must request the change in writing by emailing the Conference Organiser.

The difference in fees between the virtual-only registration and in-person registration will be due and must be paid by the Delegate upon receipt of the invoice.

The difference will be calculated on the corresponding in person rate fee.

CANCELLATION OF THE REGISTRATION BY THE DELEGATE

All cancellations must be made in writing to the Conference Organiser at da@thinkbusinessevents.com.au.

Full Conference or one-day cancellations: If you have registered for the Conference as a full, day or two day Delegate, whether virtual or in-person:

You are entitled to a refund if the cancellation is received on or before 18 July 2022. However, you will incur a \$150 administrative fee.

You are not entitled to a refund of the registration fees if the cancellation is received after 18 July 2022.

Part cancellation: If you would like to cancel part of your registration package (e.g. Additional social event tickets):

You are entitled to be refunded the fee that is applicable to the cancelled part of the package, if the cancellation is received on or before 18 July 2022. However, you will incur a \$25 administration fee.

You are not entitled to any refund of the registration fee if the cancellation is received after 18 July 2022.

Final date to claim a refund: To claim applicable refunds for cancellations or alterations, please email da@thinkbusinessevents.com.au on or before 18 July 2022. No refunds (in part or in full) will be accepted after this date, but you may choose to transfer your registration to another person within your organisation if permitted under these Terms and Conditions.

Processing time for refunds: Refunds (less applicable administrative fees) will be processed no later than 30 days after the conclusion of the Conference.

If your application for a visa to enter Australia is unsuccessful, the above cancellation terms apply.

CHANGE OF THE IN-PERSON CONFERENCE TO A VIRTUAL- ONLY CONFERENCE BY DIETITIANS AUSTRALIA OR THE CONFERENCE ORGANISER

In the event the in-person Conference cannot go ahead due government restrictions on travel or gatherings, the Conference may be delivered fully online via a virtual platform.

A fully virtual Conference means the Conference will not be hosted in Adelaide and all Delegates, Speakers, Sponsors and Exhibitors will be attending the Conference virtually.

All in-person registrations will be converted to virtual registrations.

In the above scenario, the difference in the fees for an in-person registration and a virtual-only registration will be refunded.

Processing time for partial refunds: Refunds will be processed after the Conference. The Delegate accepts that the processing time for the refund may be delayed if many registrations need to be processed.

CANCELLATION, POSTPONEMENT OR CHANGE OF REGISTRATION OF THE CONFERENCE BY DIETITIANS AUSTRALIA OR THE CONFERENCE ORGANISER

It may be necessary for reasons beyond the control of Dietitians Australia or the Conference Organiser to alter the times, dates, itineraries or Speakers of the Conference by notice to you at any time.

In the event of cancellation or postponement of the Conference, or if the registration is converted from an in-person registration to a virtual-only registration (or vice versa), the maximum liability of Dietitians Australia or the Conference Organiser is limited to a refund of the Conference registration fee with no additional liability for travel costs, hotel costs, or any other costs or expenses whatsoever.

In the event of cancellation or postponement of the Conference, or if the registration is converted from an in-person registration to a virtual-only registration (or vice versa), due to circumstances beyond Dietitians Australia or the Conference Organiser's reasonable control including but not limited to acts of terrorism, war, acts of God, natural disaster or global health crises (including any government restrictions on travel or gatherings), Dietitians Australia or the Conference Organiser cannot be held responsible for any cost, damage or expense which may be incurred by Delegates as a consequence of such cancellation, postpone or change.

In the event of postponement of the Conference, if the Delegate is willing to attend the rescheduled event, we will transfer the registration and guarantee the same conditions and registration entitlements at the rescheduled event.

The Conference will collect and store information you provide in this Registration Form for the purposes of enabling us to:

- register your attendance at the Conference;
- assist with administrative and planning purposes;
- plan and develop the Conference and other events in the future;
- facilitate your requirements in relation to the Conference; and
- allow the compilation and analysis of statistics relevant to the Conference.

The information that you provide in the Registration Form and information provided at any other time during the Conference, including without limitation any feedback obtained during the Conference, will be used by the Conference to offer, provide, and continue to improve future events and other services.

VIRTUAL PLATFORM / CONFERENCE APP

All registered Delegates' name, position, organisation, and email address will be uploaded to the virtual platform and/or app.

Delegates will receive their Conference login details direct from the virtual platform and/or app. Delegates are responsible for the setup of their own Delegate profile on the virtual platform for interaction with other Delegates, sponsors and exhibitors

Delegates are also responsible for any technical requirements to enable you to use the link to the virtual platform provided by the Conference and to participate in the Conference via the virtual platform and/or app.

Registered Delegates will be able to set their privacy preferences when they log into the virtual platform and/or app.

DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION TO THIRD PARTIES

The Conference may disclose some of the information that is collected in the Registration Form such as your name, position and organisation to Conference sponsors and exhibitors. The Conference will not otherwise, without your consent, use or disclose your personal information for any purpose unless it would reasonably be expected that such purpose is related to the offer, provision and improvement of the Conference or where such purpose is permitted or required by law.

Delegates may request to withhold consent for disclosure of their contact details to sponsors or exhibitors during the registration process or by notifying the Conference Office in writing by 18 July 2022.
